The Court CONFIRMS the tentative ruling as follows:

Plaintiff's unopposed motion for preliminary approval of class action settlement is GRANTED. Applying the factors set forth in *Dunk v. Ford Motor Co.* (1996) 48 Cal.App.4th 1796, the court makes a preliminary finding that Plaintiff meets Plaintiff's burden of showing that the settlement is fair, adequate and reasonable. The also court makes a preliminary finding that Plaintiff establishes sufficient grounds for class certification for purposes of settlement. *Dunk*, 48 Cal.App.4th 1807, fn. 19. See also, *Sav-On Drug Stores, Inc. v. Superior Court* (2004) 34 Cal.4th 319. The court sets the motion for final approval/fairness hearing for April 11, 2025, 2025 at 8:30am. The court approves the "NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT."

The court orders Plaintiff to resubmit the proposed order with the above hearing date and with the "Claim Form, Summary Notice, and Long Form Notice" (referenced in ¶ 8 as Exhibits B, C and D but omitted from the proposed order submitted to the court) referenced as, and attached as, Exhibits A, B and C.

If this tentative ruling is confirmed the Minute Order will be the final order of the court and the parties shall not submit any further order on this motion.
